IN AZERBAIJAN AND GEORGIA**

1.0. Call for Application

The Ministry of Education, Science and Technology is pleased to inform the general public that applications for the prestigious 18th Baku Summer Energy School (BSES) 2024 are now open. This program is organized by the Institute for Development and Diplomacy of ADA University in partnership with esteemed entities including the ADA University Foundation, the State Oil Company of Azerbaijan Republic (SOCAR), BP in Azerbaijan, KOLIN Azerbaijan, and GL. It presents a unique opportunity for professionals, policymakers, and scholars, to delve into critical energy and environmental issues. 2.0. Program Overview

The Baku Summer Energy School, spanning from July 8-19, 2024, offers a comprehensive two-week certificate program designed to foster a deeper understanding of global and Caspian energy and environmental challenges. Participants will engage with renowned scholars, practitioners, and policymakers, exploring a diverse range of topics such as energy fundamentals, energy law and economics, environmental issues, climate change, and more.

3.0. Application requirements

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must fulfill the following criteria:

- Be Mid-career professionals from energy companies.
- Be Policy-makers and civil servants from governmental institutions, embassies, and international organizations.
- Be Scholars, journalists, and graduate students focusing on energy and environmental issues.

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- Resume in English showcasing educational background, employment history, academic awards, and extracurricular activities.
- Recent photo (size: 5 x 5 cm).
- Passport/ID (passport for international participants, national ID for locals).

4.0. Program Cost

The tuition fee for the 2024 Baku Summer Energy School is **3,000 USD**. This fee covers teaching materials, local transportation, and extra-curricular activities, including field trips, luncheons, and a welcome reception. Participants are responsible for covering their own international travel and accommodation expenses.

NB: Please be aware that each individual will be responsible for these participation costs. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania will not offer any funding for individuals who will have the chance to enroll in this summer course. Applicants are urged to secure their own funding sources to pay for all costs.

5.0. Application Deadline
