- Hold a Bachelor's degree with at least upper second-class division level (Masters applicants); and
- ii. Hold a Master's degree (PhD applicants).

This scholarship is a **partial scholarship**. It covers **tuition fees, enrolment fees, and Stipend**. Candidates should be able to cover expenses that are not covered in this scholarship from other sources.

NB: There is no loan or grant from the Government of Tanzania for candidates who will be offered this Scholarship.
