1.0. Call for Application

This program, organized by CESI Engineering School, aims to provide participants with invaluable insights and practical skills in BIM while fostering discussions on sustainable development. 2.0. Program Overview

The Summer School offers a comprehensive curriculum focusing on BIM and its application in sustainable construction. 4.0. Application requirements

Interested applicants are required to submit:

- i. A cover letter
- ii. A CV
- iii. An identity document

5.0. Program Cost

The cost of participation is 1000 Euros per person, inclusive of tuition fees, teaching materials, and cultural visits. Kindly note that accommodation, living expenses, insurance, and visa fees are not included in the program fee.

The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania will not offer any type of funding for individuals who will have the chance to enroll in these summer course. Applicants are urged to secure their own funding sources to pay for all costs.
