PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM TENABLE IN MOROCCO FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023/2024

1. Call for Application

The General Public is hereby informed that the Kingdom of Morocco through the Moroccan Agency of International Cooperation (AMCI) has granted a quota of 30 scholarships for eligible Tanzanian nationals to pursue Undergraduate and Postgraduate studies at Moroccan Public Institutions for the academic year 2023/2024.

2. General Admission Requirements

A. Undergraduate Studies

(a) Bachelor Studies

- 1. Applicant must have completed Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) in 2021-2022 and pass with Division I or II or a Diploma with minimum of Upper Second Class;
- 2. Age not older than 23 years by August, 2024;
- 3. Not admitted in any Moroccan Higher Learning Institution; and
- 4. Medical Certificate issued by public medical hospitals certifying that you are not suffering from any contagious illness or carrying a pandemic.

B. Postgraduate Studies

(a) Masters:

- 1. Must hold a bachelor's degree with a minimum of Upper Second Class;
- 2. Not admitted in any Moroccan Higher Learning Institution; and
- 3. Medical Certificate issued by public medical hospitals certifying that you are not suffering from any contagious illness or carrying a pandemic.

(b) PhD

- 1. Must hold a Master's degree in the required subject/specialties of studies recognized as being equivalent to Moroccan granted certificate;
- 2. Not admitted in any Moroccan Higher Learning Institution; and
- 3. Medical Certificate issued by public medical hospitals certifying that you are not suffering from any contagious illness or carrying a pandemic.
- Please note: Applications with a certificate level of training in French language will have an added advantage.
 - For all programmes the language of instruction is French except for Islamic and Arabic Literature which will be conducted in Arabic Language.

There is no loan or grant from the Government of Tanzania for candidates who will be offered this Scholarship.

3. List of documents to be submitted (two (2) copies each):

- 1. Certified copy of academic certificates and transcripts;
- 2. Certified copies of birth certificate and national identification card;
- 3. A certified copy of your passport;
- 4. Medical certificate issued by public medical hospitals certified that he/she is not suffering from any contagious illness or carrying a pandemic;
- 5. Two recent passport size photographs, in colour (with the name, surname and nationality of the candidate written on the back of the photos); and
- 6. Applicant for Masters and PhD must provide a copy of an Abstract of dissertation/ thesis of graduation/ thesis for PhD degree.
- 7. Recent criminal record.

The scholarship will cover:

- (i) University tuition fees;
- (ii) A monthly allowance of 750 Dirhams (approximately \$75 USD); and
- (iii) Printing costs for dissertations and thesis (for Master's and Doctorate students).

Costs covered by the applicant (Student):

- (i) Airfare ticket, go and return
- (ii) Transportation costs
- (iii) Registration fees
- (iv) Books and stationery

Medical coverage:

Foreign students are required to subscribe to an insurance policy during their study stay in Morocco that offers them the following services:

- Reimbursement of medical expenses;
- Medical care;
- Final medical evacuation of home country in cases of serious illness that will not allow students to continue with their studies in Morocco; and
- Repatriation of body in case of death in Moroccan territory.
